

THE DRAMA HUB SCHOOL HOLIDAY PROGRAM TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Enrolment are processed on a first come, first served basis. Enrolment is confirmed with payment of term fees. We do not reserve places. There is waiting list once a class is full.
2. All drama fees are non-refundable. If a class is cancelled the fee will be credited or refunded if an alternate date cannot be arranged.
3. Students are not supervised before or after advertised class times.
4. Attendance of students not enrolled in The Drama Hub's Program is prohibited.
5. Please inform The Drama Hub on 0400 171 396 if the student is unable to attend or will be late to class.
6. Media – by submitting an enrolment form you consent as parent /guardian to the student being photographed, filmed and/or interviewed during class, rehearsal or performance.
The Drama Hub owns the copyright to all photographic images and footage. It may be made available for all media, including on-line publications. There is no time limit pertaining to these documentation materials.
7. In the event of an emergency you agree that: The Drama Hub is authorised to make medical arrangements as deemed necessary including calling an ambulance, and that you as the parent/guardian are responsible for paying all medical and/or ambulance costs that may result.
8. The Drama Hub reserves the right to withdraw a student's enrolment if their behaviour is deemed unsafe, unacceptable or inappropriate. There is no refund in this case.
9. Students are advised to bring suitable food and drinks to the workshops. However, peanuts/peanut butter and peanut based products are prohibited.
10. We prefer if parents/guardians aren't present during the entire class as this may disrupt the student performing to their full potential. We do however accept some students would like their parent/guardian there at the beginning for support, so we ask parents/guardians to sit to the side and once the student is feeling a little more relaxed we ask you quietly remove yourself from the room.
